Indect Parking Sensors Shine Bright at New Nebraska Furniture Mart in North Texas.

Parking Guidance System allows customers to quickly and easily locate open parking spaces.

Dallas, TX, (February 10, 2015) — Nebraska Furniture Mart (a Berkshire Hathaway company) recently opened a two million square foot store in *GrandScape*, a fast growing mixed-use development located in The Colony, Texas. To better accommodate its customers, Nebraska Furniture Mart built a 2,000 space parking garage that is connected to the store. Of those parking spaces, 1,625 are monitored with the INDECT Single Space parking guidance system and was supplied by Parking Guidance Systems, LLC, of Dallas, TX.

The INDECT single space parking guidance system allows the garage customer to quickly and easily identify open spaces by simply looking down an aisle. INDECT sensor activated lights, placed directly above each space will shine “Green” when the space is open, “Red” when the space is occupied, and “Blue” if the space is reserved for ADA/Handicapped drivers.

Indect Wayfinding signs were also installed on the ramps going from level to level. These indicate the number of spaces that are open on each floor. Once on the floor, additional signs direct the driver to the open spaces.

This particular installation is the first of its kind in the US Market; where the INDECT system was specified into the original construction plans. When this is done, all of the required conduit to run the INDECT system wiring is laid within the forms while the slab is being poured. There are several advantages to this:

1. There is cost savings of 20-30% on material, and installation labor.
2. Aesthetics and site lines are extremely clean, with exposed wiring or panels.
3. No exposed conduit. The only thing visible is the LED pendant installed at the end of the parking space.

The entire system is controlled with a software program that comes with the INDECT package. This system can be customized to the needs and traffic demands of the garage in a matter of minutes.
